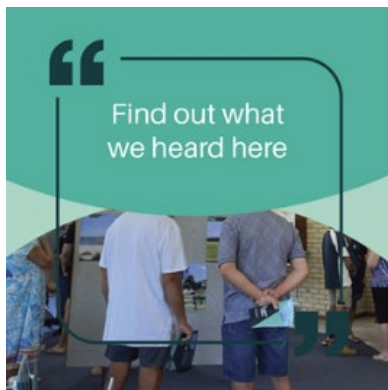


Project update
