Major Project Status

We are pleased to announce that the Murchison Green Hydrogen Project (MGH) has been awarded Major Project Status by the Hon. Ed Husic MP, Federal Minister for Industry and Science.

Through the granting of Major Project Status, the Australian Government recognises MGH as being of national significance due to its potential to create substantial economic growth, employment and regional development in Australia. MGH is one of only 19 projects in Australia to receive this status.

The Federal Government's decision further acknowledges the project's contribution to the growth of the hydrogen industry in Australia and its support of the energy transition to achieve the goal of net zero emissions.

these surveys will form the basis for the Environmental Review Document, scheduled to be submitted to the environmental regulators at the end of 2024.
